Ma's satin lacquer



Paint

Definition

Satin lacquer paint in aqueous phase (polyurethane acrylic dispersion) for interior and exterior decoration.

Properties

Resistant to aggression and scratching. Low VOC content. Easy to spread and stable gloss. Easy maintenance. Fast drying.

Application

Apply an appropriate undercoat for the type of substrate (for example, Marius Aurenti white wall acrylic primer). Stir the product thoroughly to make it uniform before and during application. Apply two coats using a short pile (6 mm) roller or acrylic brush. The product is ready to use. Clean the equipment with warm water immediately after use. Ma's lacquer must be applied, not spread. Application conditions compliant with French standard NF P 74-201 (DTU 59.1) or equivalent local standards and regulations. Ambient and substrate temperature above 8°C and below 35°C.

Substrates

Application to new or old well-prepared substrates. New substrates must be sound, clean, and dry (refer to French standard NF P 74-201/DTU 59.1 or equivalent local standard). Old substrates must be clean and free of paint flakes. They must be analysed in advance to determine the priming coat. Preparation must be performed according to standard practice.
